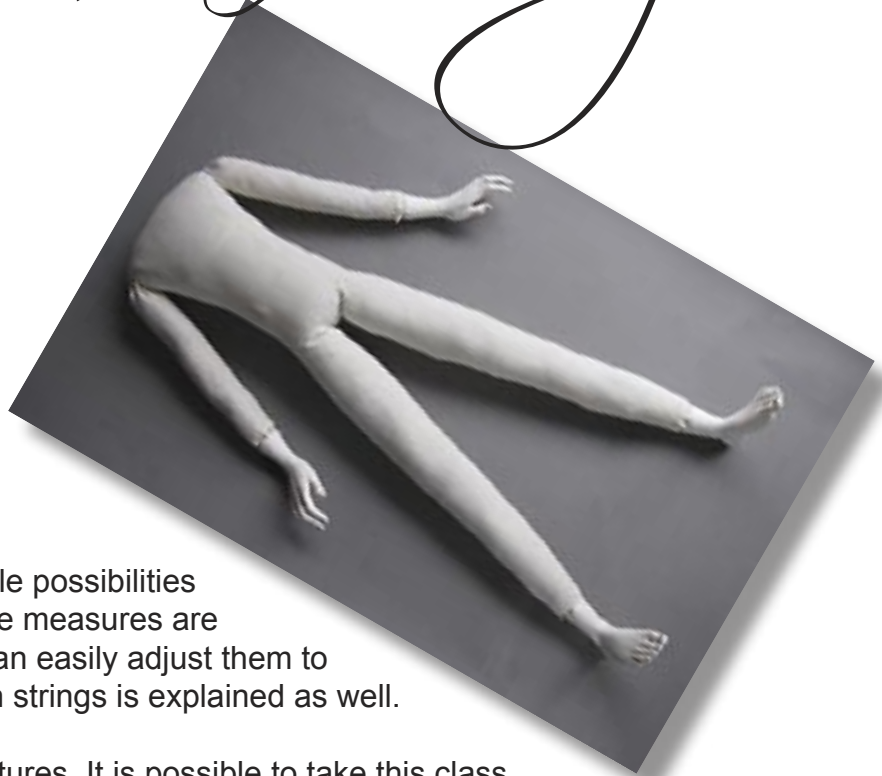

# Making a Body

for your doll



When you have finished sculpting and painting you want to put all body parts together. But how?

This lesson shows you some very simple possibilities and patterns for making a doll body. The measures are based on the size of the head so you can easily adjust them to your own doll. How to hang your doll on strings is explained as well.

It is a one lesson class with over 70 pictures. It is possible to take this class as a separate class or in combination with one or more of the following classes:

- Sculpting a doll in air drying clay (kit available)
- Painting your doll with watercolor paint
- Clothing for your doll
- Hair and hats for your (fantasy) doll

Materials needed for the body class:

Unbleached cotton (grey cloth)

Stuffing

Electric wire

Sewing machine (or sewing by hand)

Needle and strong thread (for instance button thread)

Glue

For a hanging doll you will need some additional materials, described in the lesson
