BigFootBird

Making a bird with this Styrofoam and papier maché technique is really fun because it is easy and it has a spectacular effect. Especially with high legs like this big foot bird.

Marlaine will guide you step by step through the process.

In this class you will learn several techniques and the possible variations are unlimited.

The total height of the bird will be appr.18 inches.

Size and shape can be adjusted.

Suggestions for alternatives will be given.

There is a material kit available for this class.

- \$ 69 (without tracking #)

- \$ 79 (with tracking #)

Shipping time used to be 5 - 7 working days but is longer now due to additional security measures.

The material kit includes:

- the pre-cut bird shape out of 4 inches (10 cm) thick European Styrofoam, appr. 8 inches (20 cm) long
- a one kilogramme package of 'Omya-color' papier maché, a sawdust material. Celluclay is a good alternative.
- electrical wire for the feet, the one with the copper kernel and plastic around it
- thin copper wire for the wings
- glass marbles for the eyes
- two fitting plastic tubes for the leg construction
- two brass sticks for the legs
- cotton lace for decoration
