# Painting a Doll

Sculpted in Airdrying Clay or Porcelain

## With Watercolor



Step by step you will learn how to paint your doll with watercolor paint. This method I use for both air drying clay and porcelain.

To give your doll a very personal expression also the eyes will be painted in this technique. The painting process will bring your doll alive.

Materials needed for the painting class:

Fine sandpaper  
a Pencil

Watercolor paint if possible in these colors:

- red (madder lake deep)
- blue (ultra marine)
- yellow (lemon)
- dark brown (sepia)
- black

Good quality real hair watercolor brushes #1 and #3

a White tissue  
a Waterpot  
a White porcelain plate or tile  
White gouache paint  
(Hobby) varnish matt  
(Fimo) varnish gloss

It is a one lesson class with lots of pictures. It is possible to take this class as a separate class or in combination with one or more of the following classes:

- Sculpting a doll in air drying clay (kit available)
- Making a body for your doll
- Clothing for your doll
- Hair and hats for your (fantasy) doll
